Sarah Davidson is an Associate Director of the Durable Rust Resistance in Wheat Project, based at Cornell University (Ithaca, NY, USA). Sarah received her PhD in Plant Biology from Cornell University.

The DRRW project aims to reduce the world's vulnerability to rust diseases through an international collaboration of nearly 20 institutions worldwide. The project, funded by the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation, is part of the Borlaug Global Rust Initiative and was developed in response to the emergence of a new virulence of stem rust, Ug99, in East Africa.
